- Project STAR: Sex Trafficking Advocacy and Recovery
- Counseling: Individual and group for child, adolescent and adults, in home offered
- Hospital and Police Station Support: Staff resources located on-site for immediate assistance
- Justice System Assistance: Support through the entire criminal justice process
- Prevention and Education: Programming in secondary schools, universities, organizations, businesses
- Youth Leadership and Prevention: Teaching teens to be activists for rape prevention and awareness
- **Professional Training:** For law enforcement, educators, mental health counselors, youth serving organizations and professionals
- Campus Services: Counseling and victim assistance for students, faculty and staff

Additional Facts:

- One in 10 children will be sexually abused before age 18
- An estimated 19.3% of American women and 1.7% of American men experienced rape in their lifetime
- The average lifetime cost of sexual assault is \$122,461
- Victims of sexual assault are:
 - 3 times more likely to struggle with depression
 - 4 times more likely to attempt suicide
 - 6 times more likely to suffer from PTSD
 - 13 times more likely to abuse alcohol
 - 26 times more likely to abuse drugs
