Position summary:

Under the direction of the Manager of Prevention and Outreach, this successful individual will assist with Sexual Violence Prevention and Education for youth, along with researching best practices in the field, tracking data and impact of programming, and offering training programs for professionals.

Principle Duties and Responsibilities:

- Attend Volunteer training, including Ambassador training
- Research, catalogue, and become an expert in long term gender specific and youth led programming
- Create and implement new programming in the community as needed, under the direction of supervisor.
- Educate students and community on sexual violence prevention
- Assists with the development of documents and reports.
- Answer outreach and prevention intake requests and redirect to appropriate CRCC staff
- Prepare materials for prevention lessons
- Performs other duties as assigned

- Working toward a degree in Education, Social Work, Sociology, or other related field
- Committed to the mission of CRCC to prevent sexual violence, serve, and advocate for survivors
- Dynamic and engaging public speaker for groups of different sizes
